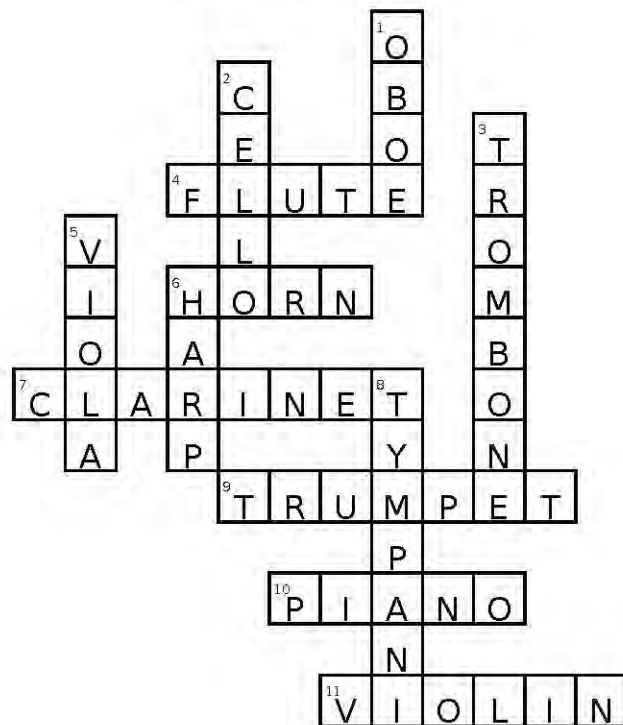


# Orchestra Instrument Crossword Puzzle



## Down:

1. This is a type of double reed woodwind instrument.
2. The player is usually seated to play this string instrument which has four strings usually tuned in perfect fifths.
3. Unlike most brass instruments, this instrument has a telescoping slide mechanism.
5. Since the 18th century, this has been the middle or alto voice of the violin family
6. This is a stringed instrument that has a number of individual strings running at an angle to its soundboard; the strings are plucked with fingers.
8. This percussion instrument consists of a head stretched over a large bowl traditionally made of copper.

## Across:

4. This is an aerophone or reedless wind instrument that produces its sound from the flow of air across an opening.
6. This brass instrument has a backward-facing orientation of the bell.
7. This instrument has a single-reed mouthpiece with almost a cylindrical bore and a flared bell.
9. There are three valves with this brass instrument, making seven different tubing lengths.
10. This instrument is played using a keyboard, which is a row of levers that cause hammers to strike the strings.
11. It is the smallest and thus highest-pitched instrument in the string family
